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Bimini provides several options to go diving for breathtaking views of great hammerhead sharks

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**Getting there:** Your best bet for cheaper fares is to drive to Fort Lauderdale and take a direct flight to Bimini (only 20 minutes). Otherwise, you are looking at a stop in Fort Lauderdale and a price point of about \$400.

**Staying there:** Bimini has a number of modest places to stay as well as higher-end resorts such as the Bimini Big Game Club Resort & Marina, which caters to divers as well as fishermen. <http://biggameclubbimini.com/>

**Diving:** A one-hour great hammerhead shark dive at the Big Game Club costs \$240. A night dive is \$75, and a three-tank dive is \$130. Dive and hotel packages are available.
